Progress Report From November 2009 to March 2010 Submitted to: MakeMyTrip.com through GiveIndia

The background:

With the support from GiveIndia, MakeMyTrip.com has been able to partner with Seva Mandir to plant thousands of saplings in Southern Rajasthan. Make My Trip has launched the campaign of planting saplings from November 2009 by encouraging its customers to donate money for planting saplings in Rajasthan to compensate the Carbon Dioxide emissions as a result of their flying through airplanes.

The partnership between Seva Mandir and Make My Trip is a result of GiveIndia's continuous support towards the pastureland program of Seva Mandir by connecting many individual donors with Seva Mandir.

Process of plantation:

The period for planting the saplings is from July to August every year. Before the plantation drive, a complete survey and site selection is carried out. A boundary wall is built around the site selected in order to protect the saplings from grazing and other hazards. The soil and water conservation activities including digging trenches, gully plugging and building check dams are carried out before planting the saplings. The pit digging and direct seeding also takes place before the monsoon comes. During the monsoon, the saplings will be planted.

After plantation the activities like weeding -hoeing, construction of Thanwla, re-digging, re-plantation, protection etc. are completed in order to promote the survival of the saplings planted. It takes a total of three years to complete all the aforementioned actions.

The status till March 2010:

As of March 2010 the selection of site and the survey has been completed. The construction of the boundary wall and soil-water conservation activities is on going at most of the sites.

We expect the construction of boundary wall, soil-water conservation, pit digging and direct seeding would be completed by June 2010 on the sites. The table below accounts the various sites being selected for the plantation this year.

July to August this year:

For the plantation season 2010 we will be planting a total of 225,000 saplings with the support received from Make My Trips. The plantation will be done on private land, pastureland, joint forest management sites, watershed development site and fruit plantation sites.

We are expecting that a total of 240,000 saplings would be planted on a total of 85 sites located in a number of villages.
